
Jacomo Sailing Club Flags



The "B" flag indicates there is a posted change in the Sailing Instructions (SI).



The "L" flag is the Come within Hale flag. When posted ashore indicates a notice to competitors has been posted. When posted afloat indicates come within hail or follow this boat.



Code flag 1 is the warning signal for all yachts with a DPN of 88.0 or higher. Code flag 2 is the warning signal for all yachts with a DPN of 87.9 or lower. Code flag 3 is the warning signal for the training/non competing yachts. When raised there are five (5) minutes until the start of the race. Lowering code flag signal the start.



The "J" flag signals that there is one start for all classes of yachts, all yachts sail the same course. It is hoisted five (5) minutes before the start and lowered at the start.




The "P" flag is the preparatory flag. When hoisted there are four (4) minutes until the start of the race. When lowered there is one minute until the start.



The "X" flag signals that a boat is over the line before the start of the race. It is the Individual Recall flag.



A General Recall for the entire class is signaled by the "First Substitute" Flag.



A postponement of the start of a race is indicated by the "Answering Pennant." When lowered the starting sequence will resume.



If the Race Committee elects to abandon (cancel) races the "N" flag will be flown.



A leeward gate is indicated by presentation of the "G" flag.



If the racecourse is to be shortened, the Race Committee will fly the "S" flag.



A change in the position of the next mark is indicated with the "C" flag.



Personal flotation devices (life jackets) must be worn by all when the "Y" flag is displayed.



The solid blue flag indicates that the committee boat is on station to finish a participants.



The START/FINISH line is a line from the orange flag on the RC boat and the red ball mark floating in the water.

Sound signals often accompany signal flags. The visual signal, the flags or pennants are the official signal, the absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded.
