

# **2018 NOVICE REGATTA**

## **NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)**

1) **RACE DATE**

2018 Jacomo Sailing Club's Novice Regatta will be held September 2, 2018. Three races are scheduled, one start, Portsmouth handicap scoring.

2) **RULES**

All races will be sailed on Lake Jacomo. Races shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), as adopted by US Sailing and the Sailing Instructions.

3) **ORGANIZING AUTHORITY**

Jacomo Sailing Club

4) **ELIGIBLE SKIPPERS**

The principal helmsman of each race shall be a Racing, Associate, Junior Racing, Junior Associate or Sailing Student from the Sailing School, a member in good standing and HAS COMPETED IN FEWER THAN 6 RACES AS HELMSMAN IN ANY CLUB SERIES OR SPECIAL RACES IN THE PAST 24 MONTHS, HAS NOT TROPHIED IN THIS EVENT BEFORE, IS CONSIDERED A NOVICE RACING SAILBOATS BY THEIR PEERS and meet all the requirements of the JSC by-laws. This changes Chapter VIII of Jacomo Sailing Club by-laws.

5) **RC ASSIGNMENTS**

The races are to be run by the Race Committee of the Day as assigned by the Jacomo Sailing Club and designated in the JSC "Sailing Instructions". The Race Committee shall record the starting and finishing times for all entrants.

6) **LAKE JACOMO REQUIREMENTS**

All yachts must meet the requirements of the Jackson County Parks and Recreation Department as they apply.

7) **STARTING TIMES**

Skippers meeting: West Side Pavilion 12:00 noon

First Race 1:30 pm

Second Race and Third Race: Shall immediately follow the previous race.

8) **COURSES TO BE SAILED:**

A) **TYPES**

T = Triangle

W = Windward and leeward

I = Windward, leeward and windward, with start and finish in the middle of leg

M = Triangle with start and finish in middle of leg

O = Triangle followed by windward, leeward and windward (Olympic)

G = Triangle followed by windward and leeward (Gold Cup)

F = "O" with start and finish in the middle of the leg (modified Olympic)

C = Catamaran triangle with start and finish in the middle of the leg

B) **COURSE BOARD INFORMATION**

You will see this information on the Race Committee course board: Red or Green plaque on the stern of the committee boat will indicate port or starboard mark rounding. Red leaves the mark to port, Green leaves the mark to starboard.

First Box = Course Number, Second Box = Compass Heading to First Mark,

Third Box = Course Diagram Signal, Fourth Box = Number of laps or partial laps.

C) **COURSES**

All rounding marks are ORANGE BALL inflatables.

9) **RACE INFORMATION**

JSC Novice Skipper Regatta

This is an intra club regatta designed to familize new sailors to club racing. Racers are encouraged to team with experienced sailors to help and coach them. Racers may use their own or a borrowed boat, this changes chapter VIII of Jacomo Sailing club by-law. It is encouraged that borrowed boats are crewed by the boat's owner or knowledgeable sailor to assist the helmsman. All yachts will sail the same course and are scored on a Portsmouth handicap basis. It will be at the PRO's discretion to set the course for each race, three races are planned. Please obtain this NOR from the public posting at the Club Bulletin Board, the club web site ([jacomosailingclub.org](http://jacomosailingclub.org)) or from the Regatta Chairman Mark Graham ([macforever@hotmail.com](mailto:macforever@hotmail.com)).

10) **TROPHIES**

Trophies will be awarded as per the Jacomo Sailing Club by-laws, one keeper trophy per 3 boats. Race results will be posted in the normal club procedure on the club website ([Jacomosailingclub.org](http://Jacomosailingclub.org)). Trophies will be awarded at the season end JSC banquet.

11) **SCORING**

Scoring will be low point system, appendix A of the current RRS with the following exceptions. Finish in Place (FNP) = # of starters. This changes RRS A4.1, A4.2 and A11. Ties will be broken using Appendix A.8 of the current RRS. One race must be completed to constitute an event. All races sailed will count.
